## CHP, LAPD, and LASO Join 11th Annual 10-4 Day Parade of Vintage Police Cars

**LOS ANGELES - (September 12, 2014)** Councilmember Tom LaBonge will join officers from the California Highway Patrol, the Los Angeles Police Department, and the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Office to speak about public safety issues at the annual 10-4 Day Parade, **to be held on Thursday, October 2**<sup>nd</sup> with staging starting **9:00 a.m.** at the **Los Angeles Fire Museum**.

Special guests include KRTH's Shotgun Tom Kelly, actors from famous TV police shows, and many more! A brief ceremony will be held at **10:00 a.m.** by Councilmember LaBonge to honor our public safety officers and all they do to protect and serve our city. The group of classic police cars will then head west on **Hollywood Boulevard**, Code 3, stopping at to pay homage to beloved television cop, **Broderick Crawford**, at his **Walk of Fame 'Movie' Star** 

Councilmember LaBonge originated the parade along with his dollar a year man, Gary Goltz, who is the #1 fan of the classic TV series *Highway Patrol* that aired from 1955-59 and starred the Academy Award Winning Best Actor of 1949. Councilmember LaBonge stated, "while the parade is intended to be fun, it does carry a serious message to heighten awareness being extra cautious when driving past routine traffic stops."
