

James Jeffrey Ryan 1942—2010


Jim Ryan's love for the automobile started as a young boy while sweeping the floors at his grandfather's dealership! After graduating from Stevens Institute of Technology, New Jersey. Jim's first career job as a technician was with Ford Motor Company and this dream job lasted for 10 years.

In 1975, Jim was hired by BMW of North America. Over the next 30 years he climbed the corporate ladder at BMW until he retired in 2002. He then worked as a consultant for both New Century BMW in Alhambra,

California and BMW Germany for their Clean Energy Program.

Jim's primary hobbies were photography and "muscle cars." He was in the process of restoring a '66 Fairlane 427-R... a dream that he was unable to fulfill when his life was cut short on January 17, 2010.

A member of many organizations and car clubs, he was Chairman of the Board of Trustees of St. Francis Medical Center Foundation in Lynwood. Since 1997, Jim was enthusiastic about the planning and leading of the annual BMW Charity Ride—a motorcycle tour of scenic areas within
